Laie Property Update

Work is in process in regards to the repair of the seawall at our Laie property. Excelsior Lodge has retained the services of Sea Engineering to perform the initial evaluation and assessment of the seawall. In November 2018, engineers from SE presented several possible options for alleviating the seawall situation to the trustees of Excelsior Lodge. These proposals included fixing the existing wall as well as the possible options for the replacement of the wall. However, all options will be dependent on what will be allowable by both State of Hawaii and City and County agencies. As of January 2019, Sea Engineering was in the early stages of exploring the possible permitting options with these agencies.

In the meantime, guests staying at the Laie property are reminded that for safety reasons, the area on the Oceanside of the seawall is absolutely off limits. The area past the white picket fence are also off limits. Guest can still enjoy all the facilities at the property but will need to access the beach from one of the public right of ways on Kamehameha Highway.

Until repairs can be completed, all members and guests are being advised to use the <u>public right of way</u> to access the beach front. For your safety and the safety of your guests, <u>DO NOT SIT OR SWIM NEAR THE SEAWARD SIDE OF</u> <u>THE SEAWALL.</u> The structural integrity of the wall has been compromised and there is the potential for <u>INJURY</u> or <u>DEATH</u> from falling concrete or a partial collapse of the seawall. The Laie caretaker is aware of this advisory and will
