

CHARITABLE COMMITTEE ANNUAL REPORT 2012 Annual budget \$12.000.00 Awarded \$7500.00 \$4500.00 Remaining balance

Sixteen (16) non-profit organizations that solicited our support received awards ranging from \$50.00 to \$1000.00. Down from 23 groups last year. That equates to an average of approximately \$468.75 per organization or 3.4% of the expended budget. Down from 4.3%

This sum represents a \$4000.00 reduction in charitable funds. As a result of this budget reduction, donations to all organizations will be scaled back and some organizations that received our support in 2012 may not be considered in 2013.
