

The Committee on Courtesies Extended submits the following Report for the 193rd Annual Communications of The Sovereign Grand Lodge held in Winston-Salem, North Carolina, August 16-22, 2019.

The Winston-Salem Marriott and the Embassy Suites, Winston Salem were the headquarters hotels for this communication.

Young people began arriving Thursday afternoon, August 15th, in preparation for the start of the Youth Days programs the following morning. 
